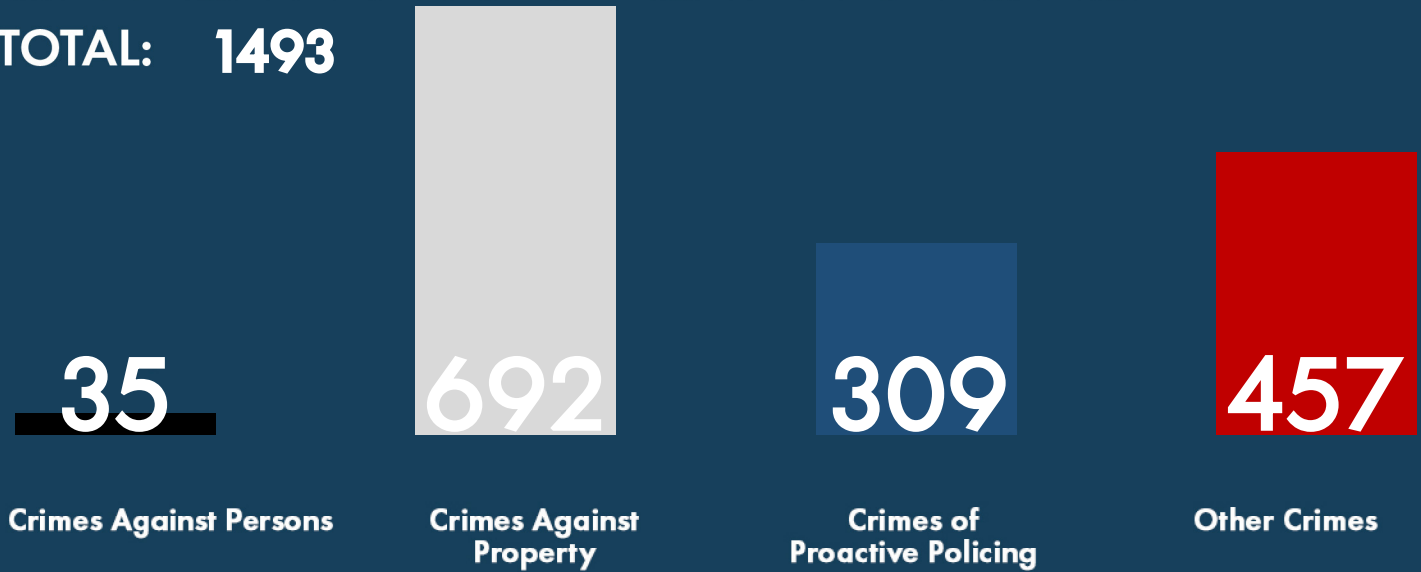

This section includes the work of several divisions within the Jonesboro Police Department. The Uniform Patrol Division is responsible for most of the Calls for Service dispatched by the E-911 Center. JPD took 6652 calls for service during August 2020, up from 6446 in July 2020. As a whole, JPD filed 1398 incident reports in August 2020, bringing the total for the year to 8331. A total of 398 Warrants were served by JPD during August 2020 across several divisions including Uniform Patrol, Street Crimes, Warrants, CID, DTF, and more.

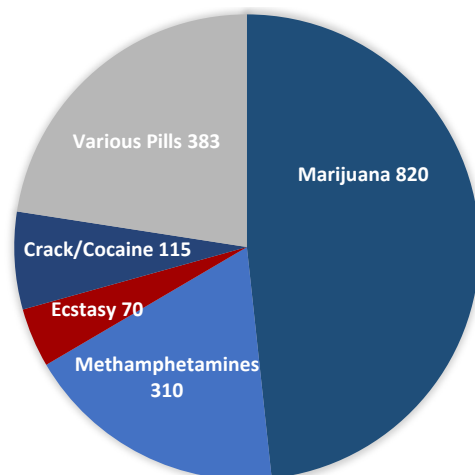

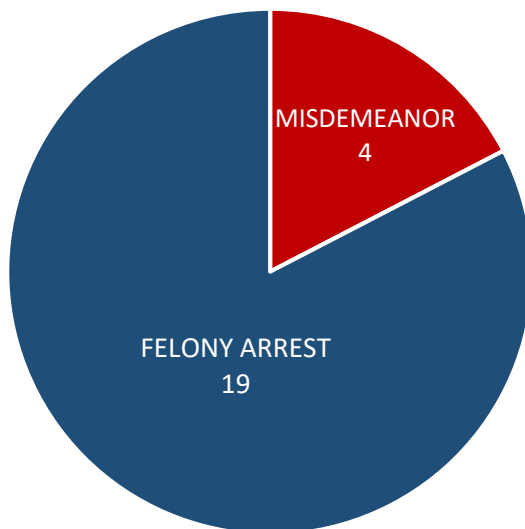

STREET CRIMES UNIT

The Street Crimes Unit specializes in criminal patrol, narcotics enforcement, gang investigation, and prostitution activity. The unit conducts directed patrols, investigates citizen complaints of street-level criminal activity, and directly assists the 2nd Judicial Drug Task Force. The Street Crimes Unit also assists any division within the Jonesboro Police Department whenever needed.

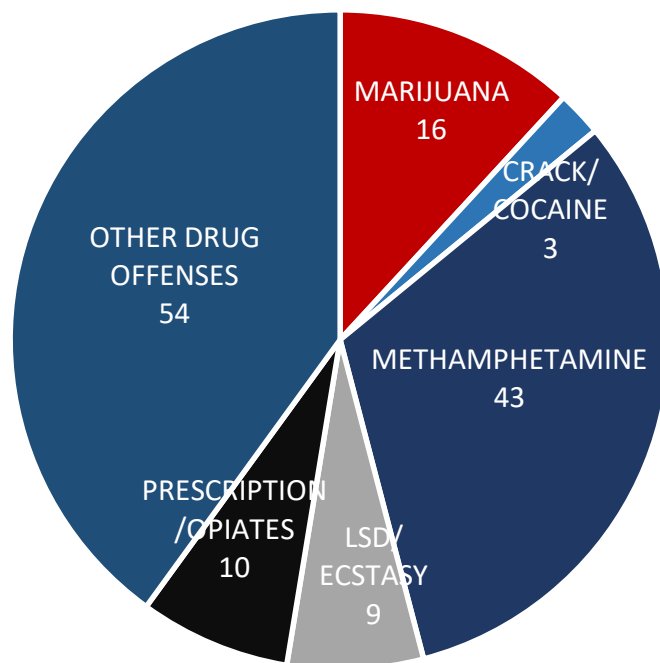

DRUG TASK FORCE

The Second Judicial Drug Task Force was established through a cooperative effort of the Second Judicial Prosecutor and District law enforcement agencies to combat narcotics and organized crime. They investigate major drug traffickers in our area, including all types of illegal drugs. They work closely with local, state, and federal agencies to eradicate drugs from our community. Currently there are eight Jonesboro Police Officers assigned to the Task Force.

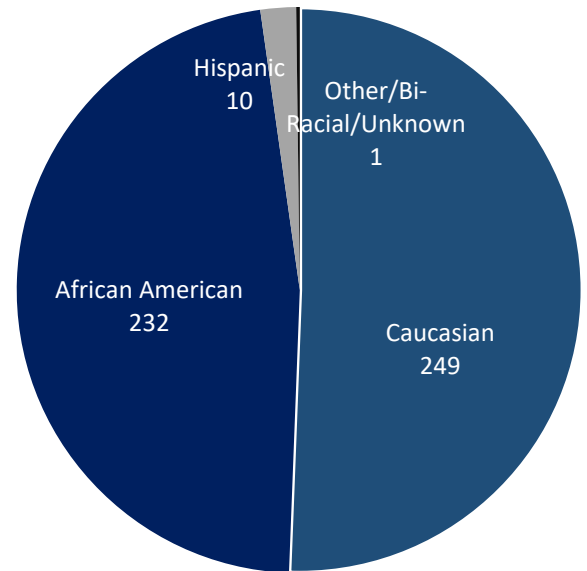
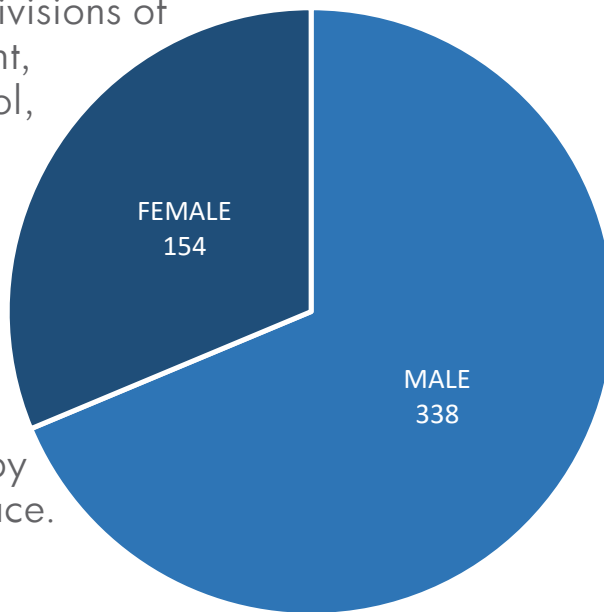

JONESBORO POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

In August 2020, there were a total of 486 arrests carried out by the Jonesboro Police Department, including 329 misdemeanor charges and 157 felony charges. Total arrests are down from 499 during July 2020. Arrests were made by all divisions of the department, including Patrol, Traffic, Street Crimes Unit, Drug Task Force, CID, and others. This section breaks down these arrests by gender and race.
